

Information sheet on illnesses in the kindergarten
What do I do if my child is sick?

Please always call the Kindergarten and report your child sick.

Fever: Children with an elevated temperature and fever (38 degrees and above) are not allowed in the Kita. Children must be fever-free for 24 hours, then you may return to the Kita.

Diarrhea/vomiting: Children who are vomiting or have diarrhea may not return to daycare until at least 48 hours after the last time they vomited or had diarrhea.

Lice: If your child becomes ill with lice, he/she will not be allowed to attend daycare. You must start treatment (shampoo, nit comb, etc.) of the head immediately. It is not allowed to come back to the daycare center until you have started the first treatment and also sign it (you will get a certificate from us). After that a second treatment will take place after 8- 10 days, again with signature.

Hand-mouth-foot disease: If your child falls ill with this disease, he/she is not allowed to go to the daycare center. It is very contagious. Usually, children get blisters on their hand, mouth and foot, often with fever as well. Your child may not return until he or she is fever-free and no longer affected.

Scarlet fever: If your child comes down with this, he or she is not allowed to attend daycare. Only after medication therapy and the symptoms have subsided may children return to the daycare center.

In general:

Children should only visit the facility when they are healthy and feeling well. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the Kita.
